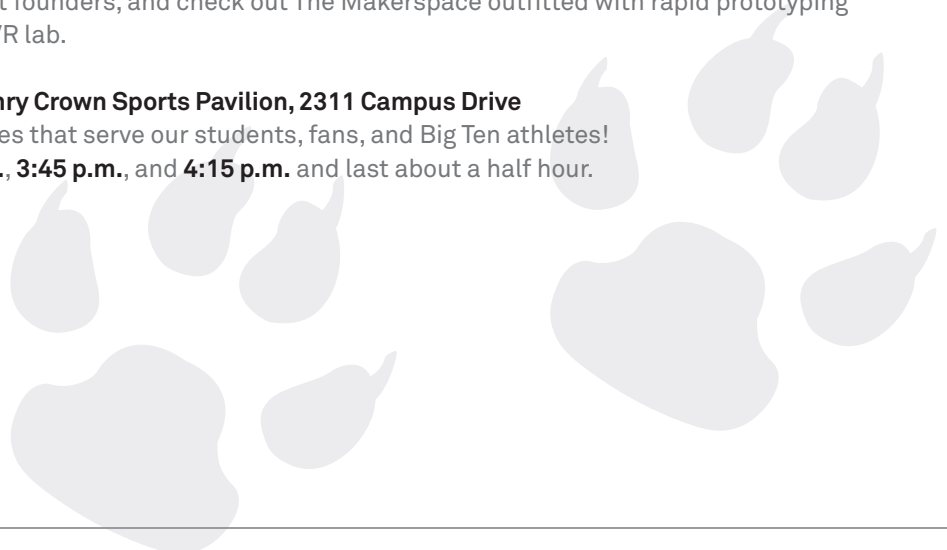
**THE GARAGE OPEN HOUSE** 2311 Campus Drive, Suite 2300
